

Visa on Arrival

The Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia presents its compliments to all appropriate airline authorities, tour agencies, and relevant Netherlands authorities, has the honour to inform them herewith that Indonesia's Ministry of Law and Human Rights has issued a newly signed decree No. M.04.IZ.01.10 (2006) dated 3 May 2006 effectuating countries that have been granted the privilege of a visa on arrival facility of which the Netherlands is included.

The Embassy further advises that under that decree, nationals included from the aforesaid list can apply for either of the following duration: 7 (seven) days maximum or 30 (thirty) days maximum and should observe the exclusive points of entry ports in Indonesia. Nationals included on that exclusivity are strictly advised that the aforementioned facility is non-extendable and non-transferable to another type of visa.

In this end, the Embassy has further the honour to convey herewith the list of countries (in alphabetical order) included on that intimation as well as the entry ports for its kind perusal and dissemination to the public.

The Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia avails itself of this opportunity to renew to all appropriate airline authorities, tour agencies, and relevant Netherlands authorities the assurances of its highest consideration.

1. Passport must be valid for a minimum of 6 (six) months as from the date entry into Indonesia
2. Onward or return tickets are compulsory
3. Payment of the visa fee
4. visitors must enter through the following airports and seaports in Indonesia
